



## National Honor Society is founded on Four Pillars:

- \* Service
- \* Leadership
- \* Character
- \* Scholarship

Freshmen who have at least a 3.5 Cumulative GPA in the spring of their freshmen year are invited to fill out an application to NHS in the spring. Notification of your eligibility will come through your first hour teacher.

Students whose applications are accepted are then given the responsibilities of a Newbie. Here is what those responsibilities look like:

- Leadership—being an active member, positive role model, and a person of integrity
- Service—participating in 10 hours of tutoring, 10 hours of NHS sponsored service, gaining a total of 90 points to be inducted, 120 are needed to collar, and attending seven general meetings, and seven committee meetings. (2 points are awarded per tutoring hour, 2 points are awarded per NHS sponsored service, 3 points are awarded per meeting, and 1 point is awarded for non-NHS points)
- Character—being a positive, helpful, and conducting one's self with honor and valor
- Scholarship—maintaining at least a 3.5 Cumulative GPA.
